### **“The Idaho State Police Association’s – National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Service Fund and Application”**

A dues increase of \$1.00 per paycheck (\$2.00 a month) was voted on and enacted May 1, 2006, by the ISPA Board Members to fund **“The Idaho State Police Association’s – National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund” (NLEOM)**. This fund will cover expenses for sending two Idaho State Police Law Enforcement Officers who are association members each year to the **“National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Services”** for fallen law enforcement officers in Washington D.C., beginning May 2007.

This fund will be used for developing a detail pool of experienced memorial attendees for the purpose of learning how to accompany and assist the families of fallen officers at the memorial services. (Other designees may be assigned by the board to attend the memorial service with the detail in the event the ISP has a fallen officer incident). While attending the memorial services, these two uniformed ISP law enforcement officers will represent this State and the Idaho State Police by carrying the ISP and State of Idaho flags in uniform during the memorial services. They will be asked to report in writing their experiences and feelings while attending the memorial which may be submitted as an article for the magazine.

Each year, except for 2007, two uniformed ISP Law Enforcement Officer Association members, will be sent to the Memorial Services to learn how and what they need to do to accompany a fallen officer’s family attending the memorial services. Each year, one ISP Law Enforcement Officer Association member, will be chosen to accompany an ISP Law Enforcement Officer Association member, who has previously attended the memorial service in order to create a pool of experienced detail attendees from all areas of the association membership around the state. In the year 2007, the first year attending, the board decided to send three uniformed association members to the memorial to begin the pool trainees.

The escorting detail service will also be available for any law enforcement agency in the state of Idaho that requests our NLEOM detail if needed.

## **APPLICATION AND PROCEDURE:**

A list of applicants will be compiled by the association board members from uniformed association members who submit a completed application to attend the memorial services. Two members from different Chapters state wide will be chosen by the ISPA Board yearly to attend the memorial. There is a good possibility that applicants may have to attend the memorial services two (2) years in a row until all trainees have attended the memorial services at least once. Changes may be needed as the applicants start to attend the services.
